SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 81

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING GEORGE SPINKS FOR HIS ACADEMIC  
2 ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND FOR HIS EFFECTIVE LEADERSHIP AS PRESIDENT OF  
3 THE PHI THETA KAPPA CHAPTER AT EAST MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

4 WHEREAS, George Spinks, a sophomore at East Mississippi  
5 Community College, was selected as a member of the Phi Theta Kappa  
6 All-Mississippi Academic Team; and

7 WHEREAS, George Spinks maintained a 4.0 grade point average  
8 in 2002 and 2003; and

9 WHEREAS, George Spinks was a Golden Key Award Winner in 2003  
10 and an All-USA Academic Team Nominee in 2003; and

11 WHEREAS, George Spinks made the President's List in 2002 and  
12 2003 and the "National Dean's List" in 2002 and 2003; and

13 WHEREAS, in recognition of his leadership ability, George  
14 Spinks was selected as the President of the Student Government  
15 Association at East Mississippi Community College; and

16 WHEREAS, George Spinks was also chosen as President of the  
17 Eta Upsilon Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa at East Mississippi  
18 Community College; and

19 WHEREAS, under the leadership of George Spinks, the Eta  
20 Upsilon Chapter attained a Five-Star Phi Theta Kappa Chapter  
21 rating, the first in the 75-year history of East Mississippi  
22 Community College; and

23 WHEREAS, the impressive intellect, effective leadership, and  
24 commitment to excellence of George Spinks has earned him the  
25 respect and admiration of his peers and the faculty at East  
26 Mississippi Community College; and



27           WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Senate to recognize and  
28 commend the academic accomplishments and leadership of the youth
