- 9 closed out the final round of the state finals, taking first and

- 14 Jackson Area Home Schoolers, Long Beach, St. John's and North
- 15 Delta Academy to advance to the final round which was held in The
- 16 Mississippi Supreme Court Chamber.
- 17 WHEREAS, Team 2, led by Junior Ali McCoy, bested defending
- 18 State Champions St. Andrews, Murrah, Warren Central and
- 19 Mississippi School for Math and Science. The two undefeated
- 20 Hattiesburg High School Teams met in the title match; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Team 1 will now represent Mississippi at the
- 22 National Finals in New Orleans the first week in May 2003. Team 1
- 23 consists of Grace Juneau, Chelsea Lovitt, Susan McKay and Scott
- 24 Varnado, attorneys; and Kennon Hulett, Katie Mapp, Rachel Evanson,
- 25 and Molly Southern, witnesses; Team 2 members are Stephen Goggin,
- 26 Ali McCoy and Stephanie Willis, attorneys; Ben Anderson, Annie

- 27 Dixon, Grant McKay, Margaret Roberts and Britney Hickman,
- 28 witnesses; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Michael Marks and R. Scott Waldrop served as teacher
- 30 coaches. "Mississippi has only claimed the National Championship
- 31 once in the history of the program", says Hattiesburg Attorney
- 32 Carey Varnado, who serves as attorney coach for the team. "It's
- 33 time that changed"; and
- 34 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the unique
- 35 accomplishment of this brilliant team of Mississippi students,
- 36 whose practice and hard work have brought honor to their school,
- 37 their community and to the State of Mississippi:
