- Football Hall Of Fame and Mississippi Hall Of Fame member, Walter 17
- Payton, at Jackson State University; and 18
- 19 WHEREAS, Jackie Slater was a 3rd round draft choice, 86th
- pick overall, by the Los Angeles Rams in the 1976 National 20
- Football League Draft, played for the Rams in Los Angeles and St. 21
- 22 Louis from 1976-1995 and set team records for most seasons played
- (20), most games played in a career (259), and most career 23
- postseason games played (18); and 24
- WHEREAS, he holds the National Football League record for 25
- most seasons played with the same club (20), fourth on National 26
- 27 Football League all-time participation chart behind Jan Stenerud,
- Jim Marshall, and George Blanda, Slater blocked in 107 different 28

- 29 100 yards rushing games and 27 different 300 yard passing games,
- 30 he cleared the way for 7 different 1,000 yard rushers, paved a
- 31 path for 23 different quarterbacks and 36 different running backs;
