A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MILDRETTE "MIDGE" 1 NETTER GRAVES, OLYMPIC GOLD MEDAL WINNER IN TRACK FROM ROSEDALE, 2 MISSISSIPPI, UPON HER INDUCTION INTO THE MISSISSIPPI SPORTS HALL 3 OF FAME CLASS OF 2003. 4 WHEREAS, the Jackson Touchdown Club and Mississippi Sports 5 Hall of Fame has unveiled the Class of 2003 of the Mississippi 6 Sports Hall of Fame, which features Mildrette "Midge" Netter 7 Graves, Hall of Fame Olympic Gold Medal winner from Rosedale, 8 9 Mississippi, who starred in track at Alcorn A & M (now Alcorn 10 State); and WHEREAS, Ms. Mildrette Graves attended West Bolivar High 11 School where she participated in basketball, band, track and 12 cheerleading; and 13 WHEREAS, she was three-time All SWAC and All-NAIA track 14 performer at Alcorn from 1968-1972; and 15 WHEREAS, she was a member of the 4x100 relay team that won 16 17 the Gold Medal for the United States in the 1968 Summer Olympics in Mexico City, participated on AAU International track team that 18 competed in Norway and Poland in 1968 and 1969, toured as part of 19 the United States European Track and Field Tour between 1969-1970, 20 and was named AAU Regional Outstanding Athlete and Female Athlete 21 of the Year by the 100% Wrong Club of Atlanta, Georgia, in 1969; 22 23 and WHEREAS, Mildrette was a superb high school girls track coach 24 for over 25 years at Leland, the Moss Point school system 25

26 (Magnolia Junior High, Charlotte Hyatt and West Elementary) and

WHEREAS, she led her girls' track squads to four conference 28 29 titles, ten district championships, two district runner-up 30 finishes, four North State crowns and two South State banners; and WHEREAS, she was five-time Delta Valley Conference girls 31 32 track Coach of the Year, two-time Regional Coach of the Year by 33 the National High School Athletic Coaches Association; and she was selected as Olympic torchbearer in 1996 for the Atlanta Summer 34 Olympics, enshrined in the Alcorn State Hall of Honor (1992), the 35 SWAC Hall of Fame (1995), the Alcorn State Athletic Hall of Fame 36 (1996), the Rosedale-West Bolivar High School Hall of Fame (1998), 37 and the Bob Hayes Track Hall of Fame; and 38
