- 20 Executive Committee; she and her husband founded Corinth's Slug
- 21 Burger Festival, which is a major event held each summer in the

- 24 raised by her grandparents, Dora and Enoch Walden; she had two
- 25 children, Rebecca and David, and two stepchildren, Randy and
