SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 102

1 A RESOLUTION URGING LAW ENFORCEMENT PROFESSIONALS TO CLARIFY
2 THE PROCEDURE BY WHICH A BAIL BONDSMAN IS TO RETURN A DEFENDANT
3 WHO IS ARRESTED OR HELD ON CHARGES IN A FOREIGN JURISDICTION; AND
4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI,
6 That the law enforcement profession is urged to interpret Section
7 99-5-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, to provide that, upon release
8 from incarceration in a foreign jurisdiction, a bail bondsman is
9 to return a defendant at no cost to the county or by reimbursing
10 the county the reasonable cost of the return of the defendant
11 where the foreign jurisdiction will not release a defendant to any
12 person other than a law enforcement officer.
