REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1457: Court proceedings; private way of necessity; circuit court to determine necessity.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 65-7-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 amended as follows:

65-7-201. When any person shall desire to have a private 10 road laid out through the land of another, when necessary for 11 12 ingress and egress, he shall apply by petition, stating the facts 13 and reasons, to the special court of eminent domain created under Section 11-27-3 of the county where the land or part of it is 14 located, and the case shall proceed as nearly as possible as 15 provided in Title 11, Chapter 27 for the condemnation of private 16 property for public use. The court sitting without a jury shall 17 determine the reasonableness of the application. The owner of the 18 property shall be a necessary party to the proceedings. 19 If the 20 court finds in favor of the petitioner, * * * all damages that the jury determines the landowner should be compensated for shall be 21 22 assessed against and shall be paid by the person applying for the private road, and he shall pay all the costs and expenses incurred 23 in the proceedings. 24

25 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-7-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT PROCEEDINGS TO ESTABLISH A PRIVATE WAY OF 3 NECESSITY THROUGH THE LANDS OF ANOTHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING 4 INGRESS AND EGRESS SHALL BE FILED WITH AND DETERMINED BY THE 5 SPECIAL COURT OF EMINENT DOMAIN OF THE COUNTY WHERE THE LAND OR 6 PART OF IT IS LOCATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
