REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1530: Appropriation; Mississippi Department of Transportation.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation Funds,
9	for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the

13	SECTION 2. The following offices are supported by the funds

17	provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below
18	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 41 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 48 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 49 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 50 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 51 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 52 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 53 54 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 56

57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

63 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi

64 Department of Transportation under the provisions of Section 1 and 65 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, the following amounts 66 shall be available for expenditure in the program budgets as required by Section 27-103-127, Mississippi Code of 1972: 67 Administration and Other Expenses.....\$ 48,057,868.00 68 69 Construction.....\$ 759,343,937.00 70 Maintenance.....\$ 149,935,424.00 Debt Service.....\$ 27,881,275.00 71 Law Enforcement.....\$ 9,107,469.00 72 Aeronautics, Rails and other.....\$ 14,849,144.00 73

74 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and 75 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of 76 the Legislature that Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 77 (\$250,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of 78 Agriculture and Commerce for the Beaver Control or Eradication 79 Program during the Fiscal Year 2004.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend such funds as necessary to conduct project planning. Such project planning shall apply to all preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction projects of the department and, at a minimum, shall consist of policies for the oversight and management of project cost which:

87 (a) Establish a reasonable cost estimate for each
88 project. For purposes of this provision, projects include
89 preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and
90 construction:

91 (b) Capture and retain the initial project cost92 estimates for comparison with final actual expenditures;

93 (c) Require that any changes to a cost estimate for a 94 project will be reviewed and approved by district or central 95 office personnel. Such personnel shall be responsible for signing 96 any revision, and providing a narrative description of the reasons 97 for approving a revision;

98 (d) Capture the cost of consultants, engineers,99 attorneys, contract appraisers and other technical and

100 professional contractors used in preliminary engineering, 101 right-of-way acquisition and construction projects.

SECTION 6. (1) None of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 of this act may be expended by the Department of Transportation for construction of new highways if such highway segment is less than ten (10) miles in length unless: (a) The explanation and justification for letting such

107 a contract for a length of less than ten (10) miles is entered 108 upon the official minutes of the Transportation Commission;

(b) The commission, within ten (10) working days after entry of its explanation and justification upon its minutes, gives notice, by United States First Class Mail, and provides a copy of such entry upon its minutes, to the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of Representatives and the Chairman of the Mississippi Senate Highways and Transportation Committee.

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention Program.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend in the Capital Outlay major object of expenditure an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) resulting from funds received from third party damages.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and allocated in Section 2, not less than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) shall be expended for contracted maintenance overlay and pavement rehabilitation.

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SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority 136 137 to escalate its budget in the Capital Outlay - Other Than Equipment or the Commodities major objects of expenditure in the 138 139 Maintenance Program, with funds which were obligated in Fiscal Year 2003 for maintenance overlay projects and maintenance repair 140 projects but not completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2003, in an 141 amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00). 142 Any escalation made from the authority granted in this Section shall 143 be reported to the Chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of 144 the Mississippi Senate and the Mississippi House of 145 146 Representatives, the Chairman of the Highways and Transportation Committee of the Mississippi Senate, the Chairman of the 147 148 Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of Representatives, and the Legislative Budget Office, within fifteen 149 (15) working days after said escalation. 150

SECTION 12. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 151 152 necessary is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 153 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation Funds, not expended by the Mississippi Department of Transportation in 154 155 Fiscal Year 2003 in the Capital Outlay - Equipment major object of expenditure, as authorized in House Bill No. 1783, Regular Session 156 157 of 2002, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.....\$ 500,000.00. 158

SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall issue a warrant to Thomas Wilkinson in the amount of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-eight Dollars and Thirty-two Cents (\$2,848.32) and to Rodney Bateman in the amount of Two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$2,690.12) for unreimbursed expenses from a prior year.

SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

172 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 173 and after July 1, 2003.
