We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- H. B. No. 1534: Appropriation; District Attorneys and staff.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys and assistant 9 district attorneys of the state and paying office expenses of 10 district attorneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and 11 ending June 30, 2004.....\$ 13,001,589.00. 12 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Budget 14 Contingency Fund, created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code 15 of 1972, for the purpose of paying salaries of district attorneys 16 and assistant district attorneys of the state for the fiscal year 17 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 18\$ 518,244.00. 19 The funds provided in this section are provided for the 20 purpose of increasing the salaries of district attorneys and 21 22 assistant district attorneys as authorized by legislation enacted 23 during the 2003 Regular Session. It is the intention of the Legislature that if there is no legislation authorizing salary 24 25 increases for the district attorneys and assistant district attorneys during the 2003 Regular Session, the Budget Contingency 26 Funds provided in this section shall not be expended for any

Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Eighty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-six Dollars 45 (\$85,876.00) is provided to fund salary and office expense for one 46 (1) full-time legal assistant in the Sixth Circuit Court District 47 as authorized in Section 25-31-5(2)(f), Mississippi Code of 1972. 48 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 49 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 50 51 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 52 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 53 54 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
