The funds derived from these charges 278 shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State 279 280 Treasury to the credit of the Office of the Mississippi State Supreme Court. 281 SECTION 18. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 282 283 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for

the payment of rent for the public space in the Law Library.
