REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1540: Appropriation; Department of Archives and History.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State			
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of			
8	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History			
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending			
10	June 30, 2004\$ 8,503,195.00.			
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special			
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of			
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds			
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the			
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal			
17	year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004			
18	\$ 4,274,413.00.			
19	SECTION 3. With funds appropriated under the provisions of			
20	Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

26	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			

the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 27 28 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 29 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 31 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 35 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 36 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 37 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 38 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 39 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 40 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 41 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 42 43 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 46

47 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 48 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

53 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 54 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 55 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 56 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 57 58 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 59 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 60

61 **SECTION 5.** It is the intent of the Legislature that the 62 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 63 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 64 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 65 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 66 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 67 Archives and History.

68 **SECTION 6.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 69 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 70 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 71 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein 72 73 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 74 75 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and 76 ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 74,899.00. 77 Of the funds appropriated in this section, not more than the 78 79 amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of expenditure: 80

SECTION 8. Of the funds provided in Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 124 125 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand 126 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 127 the credit of the New Capitol Repair and Renovation Fund created 128 in Section 27-19-56.69 (8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the 129 130 purpose of paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 131 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 132 with the escalation of federal funds. 133

134 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of

this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is 135 136 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only 137 138 President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and 139 allocated in Section 3, One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 140 (\$1,500,000.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund 141 created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972. 142

SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein 143 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 144 145 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the Budget Contingency Fund, as created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, 146 to the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of 147 supporting the Statewide Oral History Project for the fiscal year 148 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 149\$ 50,000.00. 150

SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 151 152 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 153 154 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 155 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 156 SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from 157 and after July 1, 2003. 158
