REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- H. B. No. 1541: Appropriation; Arts Commission.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
10	\$ 1,308,473.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts
14	Commission which is comprised of special source funds and
15	donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for
17	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.
18	\$ 1,761,747.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

43	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of		
44	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to		
45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal		
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004		
47	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions		
48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the		
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the		
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall		
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all		
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this		
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure		
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual		
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal		
56	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,		
57	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken		
58	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected		
59	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"		
60	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which		
61	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation		
62	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until		

- 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 67 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 68 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 69 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 70 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 71 Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand
- 72 Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education
- 73 Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,
- 74 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:
- 75 Training of educators and promotion
- of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00
- 77 Miscellaneous grants and programs \$350,000.00
- 78 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 79 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars
- 80 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans
- 81 and Grants," designated for the "Challenge Program," specific
- 82 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts
- 83 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts
- 84 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
- 85 into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission
- 86 in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature.
- 87 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit
- 88 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon
- 89 appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the
- 90 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts
- 91 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be
- 92 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of
- 93 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.
- 94 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 95 Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate
- 96 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to
- 97 exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may
- 98 become available to the commission in accordance with the rules

- 99 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 100 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 101 **SECTION 7.** In addition to all other sums heretofore
- 102 appropriated, the following sum is hereby appropriated and
- 103 transferred to the State Department of Education out of any money
- 104 in the State Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund
- 105 created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi code of 1972, not
- 106 otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of funding the additional
- 107 support and operation of the 2003-2004 academic school year of the
- 108 Mississippi School of the Arts located in Brookhaven, Mississippi
- 109\$ 2,000,000.00
- 110 It is the intention of the Legislature that the funding
- 111 provided herein shall provide the authorization for thirty-one
- 112 (31) new full-time permanent positions.
- 113 Further, it is also the intention of the Legislature that the
- 114 State Department of Education shall be authorized to expend funds
- 115 from any source, including the Mississippi Alliance of School
- 116 Health, in an amount not to exceed Forty-five Thousand Dollars
- 117 (\$45,000.00), to establish one (1) full-time permanent Physical
- 118 Education Coordinator position.
- 119 **SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 120 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 121 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 122 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 123 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 124 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 125 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 126 and after July 1, 2003.
