95	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which		
96	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation		
97	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until		
98	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.		
99	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with		

100 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

101	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be		
102	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are		
103	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this		
104	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.		
105	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the		
106	Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize		
107	increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts		
108	not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amoun		
109	of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major		
110	objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar

112	SECTION 7. Of the funds provided under the provisions of		
113	this act, Six Hundred Ninety-two Thousand One Hundred Forty-seven		
114	Dollars (\$692,147.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify		
115	existing positions of this agency.		
116	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by		
117	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the		
118	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon		
119	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal		
120	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the		
121	proper person, officer or offi	cers, in the manner provided by law	
122	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from		
123	and after July 1, 2003.
