REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2741: Court reporters; revise length of eligibility for temporary certification.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. Section 9-13-121, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 9-13-121. (1) (a) Except as otherwise provided in 9 paragraph (b) of this subsection (1), any person graduating from 10 a * * * court reporting school * * * approved by the State of 11 Mississippi or some other state shall be given a temporary 12 certification but shall make application for and pass a Certified 13 Shorthand Reporter's (CSR) examination as is provided * * * in 14 this section.

15 (b) Any person who is enrolled in a court reporting 16 program or court reporting school, whether in Mississippi or 17 out-of-state, that is accredited by the National Court Reporting 18 Association, and who graduates prior to November 1, 2008, shall be 19 granted certification without examination.

20 (2) (a) The Board of Court Reporters shall implement a true CSR examination wherein all examinees are given the option to take 21 any part or parts of the * * * examination independent of the 22 other parts; however, each part, once passed, need not be retaken 23 by that examinee. Any applicant granted a temporary certification 24 25 or permit * * * shall be allowed not less than thirty-six (36) months after being granted the temporary certification or permit 26 27 to pass the examination.

(b) (i) Examinations for certification shall be given 28 29 not less than every six (6) months at a time and place designated by the board. Notification of such examinations shall be given 30 each applicant in writing not less than thirty (30) days before 31 each examination date. Proof of notice of an examination having 32 been sent less than thirty (30) days before an examination date 33 shall automatically extend a temporary certificate for an 34 additional six (6) months beyond what is otherwise provided in 35 36 this section. (ii) If * * * an applicant holding * * * temporary 37 certification has not qualified for certification within the 38 required time, the applicant shall be permitted a hearing before 39 the board. If said applicant has passed at least two (2) parts of 40 the examination, the applicant will be given an additional 41 extension of not more than one (1) year. 42 (iii) If a court reporter is unavailable, the use 43 44 of audio or video equipment shall be authorized. Those reporters holding temporary certificates must 45 (3) submit their applications, together with the fee, to the board and 46 take the next scheduled examination. If * * * the applicant 47 holding * * * temporary <u>certification</u> has not qualified for 48 certification within the required time, the applicant shall be 49 deemed unqualified to serve as a reporter until the applicant 50 51 passes the examination and receives permanent certification or has been granted an extension according to subsection (2). 52 Photo identification may be required of any applicant 53 (4) 54 prior to the taking of an examination for security reasons only but shall not be used for discrimination against applicants on the 55 basis of race, gender, age, creed or national origin. 56 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 57

58 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-13-121, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A PERSON MAY PRACTICE THE 3 PROFESSION OF COURT REPORTING UNDER A TEMPORARY CERTIFICATE; AND 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
