REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL: S. B. No. 2928: Appropriation; Judicial Performance Comm. We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Commission on Judicial Performance 8 of the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 10 345,902.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 12 Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund created in 13 Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of 14 defraying the expenses of the Commission on Judicial Performance 15 of the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 16 17 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.....\$ 71,000.00. SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 18 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 19 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 20 21 Permanent: Full Time 5 2.2 Part Time 0 Time-Limited: Full Time 23 0 24 Part Time 0

25 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 26 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 31 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 32 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 33 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 34 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 35 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 36 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after July 1, 2003. 38
