REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3009: City of Meridian; authorize the sale of treated effluent water from city's wastewater treatment facility.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of 8
- Meridian, Mississippi, are authorized and empowered, in their 9
- discretion, by resolution duly adopted and entered on their 10
- minutes, to: 11
- 12 Enter into contracts and agreements for a term of
- not to exceed thirty-five (35) years for the sale of treated 13
- effluent water from the City of Meridian's wastewater treatment 14
- facilities; and 15
- (b) Prescribe rates at which treated effluent water 16
- shall be sold. 17
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18
- 19 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF
- MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS FOR 2
- A TERM NOT TO EXCEED 35 YEARS FOR THE SALE OF TREATED EFFLUENT WATER FROM THE CITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES AND TO 3
- 4
- 5 PRESCRIBE RATES AT WHICH TREATED EFFLUENT WATER SHALL BE SOLD; AND
- FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
