AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2446

By Representative(s) Committee

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is hereby created the Commission on
6 Police Pursuit Standards and Procedures, which shall consist of
7 seventeen (17) members.

8 (2) The Governor shall appoint five (5) members of the
9 commission from the following specified categories:

10 (a) Two (2) members, each to be a chief of police of a
11 municipality in this state, with one (1) of such municipalities
12 having a population of less than one thousand two hundred (1,200)
13 according to the latest federal decennial census.

14 (b) One (1) member shall be a sheriff in this state.

15 (c) One (1) member shall be a district attorney in this
16 state.

17 (d) One (1) member shall be a representative of higher
18 education.

19 (3) The remaining twelve (12) members of the commission
20 shall be the following:

21 (a) The Attorney General.

22 (b) The Director of the Mississippi Highway Safety
23 Patrol.

24 (c) The President of the Mississippi Municipal

25 Association or his designee.

26 (d) The President of the Mississippi Association of
27 Supervisors or his designee.

28 (e) The President of the Mississippi Constable
29 Association or his designee and such member shall be a certified
30 law enforcement officer.

31 (f) The President of the Mississippi Police Benevolent
32 Association or his designee.

33 (g) The President of the Mississippi Law Enforcement
34 Officers Association or his designee.

35 (h) The President of the Central State Troopers
36 Coalition or his designee.

37 (i) A nonsupervisory, rank and file, law enforcement
38 officer appointed by the Lieutenant Governor.

39 (j) A nonsupervisory, rank and file, law enforcement
40 officer appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

41 (k) The President of the Mississippi Campus Law
42 Enforcement Officers Association or his designee.

43 (l) The President of the Fraternal Order of Police or
44 his designee.

45 (4) Members of the commission shall serve without
46 compensation, but shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for
47 any actual and reasonable expenses incurred as a necessary
48 incident to such service, including mileage, as provided in
49 Section 25-3-41.

50 (5) There shall be a chairman and a vice chairman of the
51 commission, elected by and from the membership of the commission.
52 The board shall meet monthly until the presentation of its final
53 recommendations to the Legislature.

54 (6) The commission shall study and make recommendations to
55 the Legislature regarding the pursuit of fleeing criminal
56 offenders by law enforcement officers. Such recommendations shall
57 address uniform methods and procedures of pursuit for the state
58 which insure the safety of the public and the apprehension of
59 criminal offenders.

60 (7) The commission shall report its recommendations to the
61 Legislature not later than January 1, 2004.

62 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
63 and after July 1, 2003, and shall stand repealed on July 1, 2004.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE COMMISSION ON POLICE PURSUIT STANDARDS
2 AND PROCEDURES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEMBERSHIP AND DUTIES OF THE
3 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
