**AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill NO. 2914**

**By Representative(s) Committee**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting  
in lieu thereof the following:**

8           **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums heretofore  
9 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
10 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
11 Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund, created in  
12 Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, not otherwise  
13 appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
14 Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending  
15 June 30, 2003..... \$       134,043.00.

16           This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of  
17 defraying the costs of certain outside legal assistance, expert  
18 witness fees and court fees incurred by the Office of the Attorney  
19 General.

20           **SECTION 2.** In addition to all other sums heretofore  
21 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
22 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
23 Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund, created in  
24 Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, not otherwise  
25 appropriated, for the purpose of paying a judgment rendered  
26 against the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year ending June  
27 30, 2003..... \$       3,187.00.

28           This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of  
29   paying a court ordered judgment as required in Cause No. 85,361;  
30   Paul William Albrecht vs. Rebecca Elaine Albrecht, and the  
31   Mississippi Department of Human Services, State of Mississippi, in  
32   the Chancery Court of Harrison County, Mississippi, First Judicial  
33   District.

34           **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
35   the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds  
36   as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal  
37   Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
38   upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers  
39   in the manner provided by law.

40           **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
41   and after its passage.
