26	against the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year ending June

This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of paying a court ordered judgment as required in Cause No. 85,361; Paul William Albrecht vs. Rebecca Elaine Albrecht, and the Mississippi Department of Human Services, State of Mississippi, in the Chancery Court of Harrison County, Mississippi, First Judicial District.

34 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 35 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds 36 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal 37 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 38 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers 39 in the manner provided by law.
