## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
7	expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal
8	year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
9	\$ 18,709,154.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
12	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or
13	the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the
14	expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the
15	authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
16	June 30, 2004\$ 144,439,883.00.
17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:
19	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
20	Permanent: Full Time
21	Part Time 2
22	Time-Limited: Full Time
23	Part Time 1

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 25 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 26 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 27 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 28 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 29 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 30 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 32 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 34 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 35 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 36 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 37 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 38 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 39 40 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 41 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 42 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 43 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 44

45 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 46 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

51 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 52 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 53 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 54 the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating 55 the state welcome centers.

56 **SECTION 5.** The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and 57 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 58 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,

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59 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United 60 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may become available during the fiscal year for the support of the 61 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under 62 the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not 63 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved, 64 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise 65 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and 66 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 67

68 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 69 Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to 70 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 71 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 72 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 73 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 75 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 76 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 77 78 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2003. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 79 80 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2005 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 81 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 82 provided during the Fiscal Year 2004 budget request process. 83

**SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of Four Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$4,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2004. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

91 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 92 the amount of One Million Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars 93 (\$1,067,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is

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94 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and 95 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2004. 96 The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be 97 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

98 SECTION 10. In addition to all other sums herein 99 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 100 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 101 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 102 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for 103 Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning 104 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 ..... \$1,300,000.00.

The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 105 106 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the 107 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and 108 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 109 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi 110 111 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 112 113 Development Authority.

SECTION 11. In addition to all other sums herein 114 115 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 116 117 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 118 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce 119 120 Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending 121 June 30, 2004.....\$ 1,209,130.00. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and 122 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 123

124 Development Authority.

SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds to HR05\SB2940A.J 129 support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce Initiative, for 130 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 131 .....\$ 3,746,558.00.

SECTION 13. None of the funds appropriated in Section 2
shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of
Representatives and Mississippi Senate representing such districts
are notified at least five (5) days prior to the awarding of
Community Development Block Grants or any other grants to their
districts.

SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 138 139 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 140 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 141 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 142 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 143 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 144 145 and after July 1, 2003.
