32	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of	
33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to	
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal	
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004	
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions	
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the	
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the	
39	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall	
40	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all	
41	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this	
42	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure	
43	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual	
44	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal	
45	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,	
46	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken	
47	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

- 62 **SECTION 3.** The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable
- 63 rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate
- 64 and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce
- 65 marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for
- 66 regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said
- 67 facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable
- 68 charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the
- 69 area contiguous to the stadium. The net proceeds from such
- 70 parking shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of

- 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 79 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
