- 133 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 134 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 135 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 136 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 137 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 138 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
- 139 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
- 140 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
- 141 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
- 142 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
- 143 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 144 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

- 159 and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention
- 160 of the Legislature that any contractual service payments made by
- 161 the department to defray medical expenses for inmates shall be at
- 162 the currently established Medicaid reimbursement rate; however, if
- 163 hospital and medical providers will not contract at the Medicaid

- 204 **SECTION 10.** It is the intent of the Legislature that all
- 205 prisoners at Parchman shall work a minimum of eight (8) hours per
- 206 day, excluding prisoners with a physical disability or those
- 207 incarcerated in maximum security.
- 208 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 209 Department of Corrections shall have the authority to accept,
- 210 budget and expend any special funds collected or otherwise
- 211 available, through the sell of scrap or recycled material, for the
- 212 purpose of providing recycling equipment, supplies or services for
- 213 use within the department.
- 214 **SECTION 12.** None of the funds appropriated herein can be
- 215 directly or indirectly associated with the ACA accreditation in
- 216 the Community Services Division.
- 217 **SECTION 13.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 218 per diem rates paid to regional facilities shall not exceed
- 219 Twenty-nine Dollars and Seventy-four Cents (\$29.74) per inmate.
- 220 All regional facilities shall continue to receive the annual three
- 221 percent (3%) increase in the per diem rate as authorized in
- 222 Section 47-5-933, Mississippi Code of 1972, however, in no event
- 223 shall any regional facility's per diem rate exceed Twenty-nine
- 224 Dollars and Seventy-four Cents (\$29.74) per inmate.
- 225 **SECTION 14.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 226 Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Corrections may
- 227 transfer between all budgets authorized in Section 3, including
- 228 Support, Medical Services, Parole Board, Farming Operations,
- 229 Private Prisons, both positions and funds in an amount not to
- 230 exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the authorized budgets in the
- 231 aggregate. The Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of
- 232 Corrections shall submit written justification for the transfer to
- 233 the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of Finance and
- 234 Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to
- 235 the effective date of the transfer. However, no transfers shall

- 236 be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
- 237 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits" in any budget authorized in
- 238 Section 3 of this act.
- 239 **SECTION 15.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 240 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 241 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 242 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 243 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 244 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 245 **SECTION 16.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 246 and after July 1, 2003.
