32	With the funds	herein appropriated, it	is the intention of		
33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to				
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal				
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004				
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions				
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the				
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the				
39	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall				
40	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all				
41	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this				
42	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure				
43	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual				
44	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal				
45	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,				
46	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken				
47	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected				
48	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"				
49	appropriated level,	when annualized, then o	only those actions whic	h	
50	reduce the projecte	d annual cost and/or the	appropriation		
51	requirement will be	processed by the State	Personnel Board until

- 62 (\$152,750.00) and three (3) full-time positions are provided to
- 63 carry out the provisions of House Bill No. 1414, Regular Session
- of 2003, or Senate Bill No. 2414, Regular Session of 2003. In the
- 65 event that House Bill No. 1414, Regular Session of 2003, or Senate
- 66 Bill No. 2414, Regular Session of 2003, is not enacted into law,
- 67 it is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of
- 68 Banking and Consumer Finance shall not expend One Hundred Fifty-
- 69 two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$152,750.00) of the
- 70 funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, nor shall
- 71 the department fill more than fifty-five (55) of the full-time
- 72 positions authorized in Section 2 of this act.
- 73 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 74 this act, Seventy-six Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-eight Dollars
- 75 (\$76,478.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing
- 76 positions of this agency.
- 77 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 82 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 83 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 84 and after July 1, 2003.
