With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 40 41 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 43 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 44 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 45 46 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 51 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 52

52 Any transfers of escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

58 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of 59 this act, Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) may be used to

60 reallocate or reclassify existing positions of this agency.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 61 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 62 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 63 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 64 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 65 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 66 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 67 and after July 1, 2003. 68
