- 12 and knowingly violated the provisions of this chapter, the court
- 13 may impose a civil penalty upon the public body in a sum not to

- 15 <u>incurred by the person or persons in bringing suit to enforce this</u>
- 16 <u>chapter.</u>
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
