## \*\*\*Adopted\*\*\* AMENDMENT No. 1 TO AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 897

## By Senator(s) Chaney

1 AMEND by striking lines 1986 through 2273 and substituting 2 the following in lieu thereof:

The State Department of Health may grant approval for (3) 3 and issue certificates of need to any person proposing the new 4 construction of, addition to, conversion of beds of or expansion 5 of any health care facility defined in subparagraph (x) 6 7 (psychiatric residential treatment facility) of Section 41-7-173(h). The total number of beds which may be authorized by 8 such certificates of need shall not exceed three hundred 9 thirty-four (334) beds for the entire state. 10

(a) Of the total number of beds authorized under this 11 12 subsection, the department shall issue a certificate of need to a 13 privately-owned psychiatric residential treatment facility in Simpson County for the conversion of sixteen (16) intermediate 14 care facility for the mentally retarded (ICF-MR) beds to 15 psychiatric residential treatment facility beds, provided that 16 facility agrees in writing that the facility shall give priority 17 for the use of those sixteen (16) beds to Mississippi residents 18 who are presently being treated in out-of-state facilities. 19 The certificate of need issued under authority of 20 (b) this paragraph (b) is hereby rescinded, and any certificate of 21 need issued under authority of this paragraph (b) shall be void 22

23 and of no effect. \* \* \*

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(C) Of the total number of beds authorized under this 25 26 subsection, the department shall issue a certificate of need to a hospital currently operating Medicaid-certified acute psychiatric 27 beds for adolescents in DeSoto County, for the establishment of a 28 forty-bed psychiatric residential treatment facility in DeSoto 29 County, provided that the hospital agrees in writing (i) that the 30 hospital shall give priority for the use of those forty (40) beds 31 to Mississippi residents who are presently being treated in 32 out-of-state facilities, and (ii) that no more than fifteen (15) 33 of the beds at the psychiatric residential treatment facility will 34 35 be certified for participation in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.), and that no claim will be submitted for 36 Medicaid reimbursement for more than fifteen (15) patients in the 37 psychiatric residential treatment facility in any day or for any 38 patient in the psychiatric residential treatment facility who is 39 40 in a bed that is not Medicaid-certified. This written agreement by the recipient of the certificate of need shall be a condition 41 of the issuance of the certificate of need under this paragraph, 42 and the agreement shall be fully binding on any subsequent owner 43 of the psychiatric residential treatment facility if the ownership 44 45 of the facility is transferred at any time after the issuance of the certificate of need. After this written agreement is 46 executed, the Division of Medicaid and the State Department of 47 Health shall not certify more than fifteen (15) of the beds in the 48 psychiatric residential treatment facility for participation in 49 50 the Medicaid program. If the psychiatric residential treatment facility violates the terms of the written agreement by admitting 51 52 or keeping in the facility on a regular or continuing basis more than fifteen (15) patients who are participating in the Medicaid 53 54 program, the State Department of Health shall revoke the license 55 of the facility, at the time that the department determines, after a hearing complying with due process, that the facility has 56 violated the condition upon which the certificate of need was 57 issued, as provided in this paragraph and in the written 58

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59 agreement.

Of the total number of beds authorized under this 60 (d) 61 subsection, the department may issue a certificate or certificates of need for the construction or expansion of psychiatric 62 residential treatment facility beds or the conversion of other 63 beds to psychiatric treatment facility beds, not to exceed thirty 64 (30) psychiatric residential treatment facility beds, in either 65 Alcorn, Tishomingo, Prentiss, Lee, Itawamba, Monroe, Chickasaw, 66 Pontotoc, Calhoun, Lafayette, Union, Benton or Tippah County. 67

(e) Of the total number of beds authorized under this 68 69 subsection (3) the department shall issue a certificate of need to a privately-owned, nonprofit psychiatric residential treatment 70 71 facility in Hinds County for an eight-bed expansion of the facility, provided that the facility agrees in writing that the 72 facility shall give priority for the use of those eight (8) beds 73 to Mississippi residents who are presently being treated in 74 75 out-of-state facilities.

76 (f) The department shall issue a certificate of need to a one-hundred-thirty-four-bed specialty hospital located on 77 78 twenty-nine and forty-four one-hundredths (29.44) commercial acres at 5900 Highway 39 North in Meridian (Lauderdale County), 79 80 Mississippi, for the addition, construction or expansion of child/adolescent psychiatric residential treatment facility beds 81 in Lauderdale County. As a condition of issuance of the 82 certificate of need under this paragraph, the facility shall give 83 priority in admissions to the child/adolescent psychiatric 84 85 residential treatment facility beds authorized under this paragraph to patients who otherwise would require out-of-state 86 placement. The Division of Medicaid, in conjunction with the 87 Department of Human Services, shall furnish the facility a list of 88 89 all out-of-state patients on a quarterly basis. Furthermore, 90 notice shall also be provided to the parent, custodial parent or 91 guardian of each out-of-state patient notifying them of the priority status granted by this paragraph. For purposes of this 92 paragraph, the provisions of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring 93

substantial compliance with the projection of need as reported in 94 95 the current State Health Plan are waived. The total number of 96 child/adolescent psychiatric residential treatment facility beds that may be authorized under the authority of this paragraph shall 97 be sixty (60) beds. There shall be no prohibition or restrictions 98 on participation in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et 99 100 seq.) for the person receiving the certificate of need authorized 101 under this paragraph or for the beds converted pursuant to the authority of that certificate of need. 102

103 (q) Of the total number of beds authorized under this 104 subsection, the department shall, immediately upon passage of this House Bill No. 897, 2003 Regular Session, issue a certificate of 105 need for the construction or expansion of psychiatric residential 106 107 treatment facility beds or the conversion of other beds to psychiatric residential treatment facility beds in Warren County, 108 109 not to exceed sixty (60) psychiatric residential treatment 110 facility beds, provided that the facility agrees in writing that no more than thirty (30) of the beds at the psychiatric 111 residential treatment facility will be certified for participation 112 in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.) for the use of 113 114 any patients other than those who are participating only in the Medicaid program of another state, and that no claim will be 115 submitted to the Division of Medicaid for Medicaid reimbursement 116 117 for more than thirty (30) patients in the psychiatric residential treatment facility in any day or for any patient in the 118 119 psychiatric residential treatment facility who is in a bed that is 120 not Medicaid-certified. This written agreement by the recipient 121 of the certificate of need shall be a condition of the issuance of 122 the certificate of need under this paragraph, and the agreement 123 shall be fully binding on any subsequent owner of the psychiatric 124 residential treatment facility if the ownership of the facility is 125 transferred at any time after the issuance of the certificate of 126 need. After this written agreement is executed, the Division of 127 Medicaid and the State Department of Health shall not certify more than thirty (30) of the beds in the psychiatric residential 128

treatment facility for participation in the Medicaid program for 129 130 the use of any patients other than those who are participating only in the Medicaid program of another state. If the psychiatric 131 residential treatment facility violates the terms of the written 132 agreement by admitting or keeping in the facility on a regular or 133 134 continuing basis more than thirty (30) patients who are 135 participating in the Mississippi Medicaid program, the State Department of Health shall revoke the license of the facility, at 136 the time that the department determines, after a hearing complying 137 138 with due process, that the facility has violated the condition upon which the certificate of need was issued, as provided in this 139 paragraph and in the written agreement. 140

From and after July 1, 1993, the department shall 141 (4) (a) not issue a certificate of need to any person for the new 142 construction of any hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical 143 dependency hospital that will contain any child/adolescent 144 145 psychiatric or child/adolescent chemical dependency beds, or for 146 the conversion of any other health care facility to a hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency hospital that will 147 148 contain any child/adolescent psychiatric or child/adolescent chemical dependency beds, or for the addition of any 149 150 child/adolescent psychiatric or child/adolescent chemical dependency beds in any hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical 151 dependency hospital, or for the conversion of any beds of another 152 category in any hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical 153 dependency hospital to child/adolescent psychiatric or 154 155 child/adolescent chemical dependency beds, except as hereinafter 156 authorized:

(i) The department may issue certificates of need 157 to any person for any purpose described in this subsection, 158 provided that the hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical 159 160 dependency hospital does not participate in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.) at the time of the application for the 161 162 certificate of need and the owner of the hospital, psychiatric 163 hospital or chemical dependency hospital agrees in writing that SS02\HB897A.1J

the hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency hospital 164 165 will not at any time participate in the Medicaid program or admit 166 or keep any patients who are participating in the Medicaid program 167 in the hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency hospital. This written agreement by the recipient of the 168 169 certificate of need shall be fully binding on any subsequent owner of the hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency 170 hospital, if the ownership of the facility is transferred at any 171 time after the issuance of the certificate of need. Agreement 172 that the hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency 173 174 hospital will not participate in the Medicaid program shall be a condition of the issuance of a certificate of need to any person 175 under this subparagraph (a)(i), and if such hospital, psychiatric 176 hospital or chemical dependency hospital at any time after the 177 issuance of the certificate of need, regardless of the ownership 178 of the facility, participates in the Medicaid program or admits or 179 180 keeps any patients in the hospital, psychiatric hospital or 181 chemical dependency hospital who are participating in the Medicaid program, the State Department of Health shall revoke the 182 183 certificate of need, if it is still outstanding, and shall deny or revoke the license of the hospital, psychiatric hospital or 184 185 chemical dependency hospital, at the time that the department determines, after a hearing complying with due process, that the 186 187 hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency hospital has 188 failed to comply with any of the conditions upon which the certificate of need was issued, as provided in this subparagraph 189 190 and in the written agreement by the recipient of the certificate of need. 191

(ii) The department may issue a certificate of need for the conversion of existing beds in a county hospital in Choctaw County from acute care beds to child/adolescent chemical dependency beds. For purposes of this subparagraph, the provisions of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring substantial compliance with the projection of need as reported in the current State Health Plan is waived. The total number of beds that may be SS02\HB897A.1J

authorized under authority of this subparagraph shall not exceed 199 200 twenty (20) beds. There shall be no prohibition or restrictions on participation in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et 201 202 seq.) for the hospital receiving the certificate of need authorized under this subparagraph (a) (ii) or for the beds 203 204 converted pursuant to the authority of that certificate of need. 205 (iii) The certificate of need issued under authority of this subparagraph (iii) is hereby rescinded, and any 206 certificate of need issued under authority of this subparagraph 207 (iii) shall be void and of no effect. \* \* \* 208

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The department shall issue a certificate of 210 (iv) need to the Region 7 Mental Health/Retardation Commission for the 211 construction or expansion of child/adolescent psychiatric beds or 212 the conversion of other beds to child/adolescent psychiatric beds 213 in any of the counties served by the commission. For purposes of 214 215 this subparagraph, the provisions of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring 216 substantial compliance with the projection of need as reported in the current State Health Plan is waived. The total number of beds 217 218 that may be authorized under the authority of this subparagraph shall not exceed twenty (20) beds. There shall be no prohibition 219 220 or restrictions on participation in the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.) for the person receiving the certificate of 221 need authorized under this subparagraph (a) (iv) or for the beds 222 223 converted pursuant to the authority of that certificate of need.

The department may issue a certificate of need 224 (v) 225 to any county hospital located in Leflore County for the construction or expansion of adult psychiatric beds or the 226 conversion of other beds to adult psychiatric beds, not to exceed 227 twenty (20) beds, provided that the recipient of the certificate 228 of need agrees in writing that the adult psychiatric beds will not 229 230 at any time be certified for participation in the Medicaid program and that the hospital will not admit or keep any patients who are 231 participating in the Medicaid program in any of such adult 232 psychiatric beds. This written agreement by the recipient of the 233 SS02\HB897A.1J

certificate of need shall be fully binding on any subsequent owner 234 235 of the hospital if the ownership of the hospital is transferred at any time after the issuance of the certificate of need. Agreement 236 237 that the adult psychiatric beds will not be certified for participation in the Medicaid program shall be a condition of the 238 issuance of a certificate of need to any person under this 239 subparagraph (a)(v), and if such hospital at any time after the 240 issuance of the certificate of need, regardless of the ownership 241 242 of the hospital, has any of such adult psychiatric beds certified for participation in the Medicaid program or admits or keeps any 243 244 Medicaid patients in such adult psychiatric beds, the State Department of Health shall revoke the certificate of need, if it 245 is still outstanding, and shall deny or revoke the license of the 246 hospital at the time that the department determines, after a 247 hearing complying with due process, that the hospital has failed 248 to comply with any of the conditions upon which the certificate of 249 250 need was issued, as provided in this subparagraph and in the 251 written agreement by the recipient of the certificate of need.

(vi) The department may issue a certificate or 252 253 certificates of need for the expansion of child psychiatric beds or the conversion of other beds to child psychiatric beds at the 254 255 University of Mississippi Medical Center. For purposes of this subparagraph (a)(vi), the provision of Section 41-7-193(1) 256 requiring substantial compliance with the projection of need as 257 258 reported in the current State Health Plan is waived. The total number of beds that may be authorized under the authority of this 259 260 subparagraph (a) (vi) shall not exceed fifteen (15) beds. There shall be no prohibition or restrictions on participation in the 261 Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.) for the hospital 262 receiving the certificate of need authorized under this 263 subparagraph (a) (vi) or for the beds converted pursuant to the 264 265 authority of that certificate of need.

266 (vii) The department shall, immediately upon
267 passage of this House Bill No. 897, 2003 Regular Session, issue a
268 certificate of need for the construction or expansion of

child/adolescent psychiatric beds or the conversion of other beds 269 270 to child/adolescent psychiatric beds in Warren County. For purposes of this subparagraph, the provisions of Section 271 <u>41-7-193(1)</u> requiring substantial compliance with the projection 272 of need as reported in the current State Health Plan are waived. 273 274 The total number of beds that may be authorized under the authority of this subparagraph shall not exceed twenty (20) beds. 275 There shall be no prohibition or restrictions on participation in 276 the Medicaid program (Section 43-13-101 et seq.) for the person 277 receiving the certificate of need authorized under this 278 subparagraph (a) (vii) or for the beds converted pursuant to the 279 authority of that certificate of need. 280 281 (b) From and after July 1, 1990, no hospital, psychiatric hospital or chemical dependency hospital shall be 282 authorized to add any child/adolescent psychiatric or 283 child/adolescent chemical dependency beds or convert any beds of 284 285 another category to child/adolescent psychiatric or 286 child/adolescent chemical dependency beds without a certificate of need under the authority of subsection (1)(c) of this section. 287 288 FURTHER, amend the title amendment by inserting the following after the semicolon on line 57: 289 TO RESCIND A CERTAIN CERTIFICATE OF NEED AUTHORIZING PSYCHIATRIC 290 RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY BEDS IN WARREN COUNTY AND TO 291 RESCIND A CERTAIN CERTIFICATE OF NEED AUTHORIZING CHILD/ADOLESCENT 292 293 PSYCHIATRIC BEDS IN WARREN COUNTY; TO DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT
