Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) In recognition of the patriotic services 58 rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof, 59 any resident of the state who is on active duty with the United 60 61 States Army Special Forces, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 62 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 63 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 64 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 65 66 section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate 67 or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United States Army Special Forces. The distinctive license tags so 68 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 69 70 Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 71 72 tag.

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the distinctive license tag shall present proof of their active duty membership in the United States Army Special Forces to the county

tax collector. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) 84 after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license 85 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 86 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 87 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 88 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 89 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 90 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 91 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 92 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 93 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 94 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 95 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 96 97 collector.

98 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 99 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, 100 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected 101 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute 102 such collections as follows:

(a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited into a special fund that is created in
the State Treasury. Monies in the fund may be expended by the
Mississippi State Veterans Affairs Board for the maintenance,
operation and administration of state veterans homes.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
reconstruction of highways.

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section 27-19-44.2.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 122 123 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 124 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 125 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 126 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 127 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 128 129 tag.

130 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 131 132 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 133 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 134 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 135 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 136 137 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 138 139 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

140 SECTION 2. Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 141 amended as follows:

142 27-19-44. (1) For any distinctive license tag or plate
143 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, through
144 June 30, 2002, or authorized by Sections 27-19-56.37 and
145 <u>27-19-56.55</u>, the requirements of this subsection must be met
146 before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such
147 license tag or plate. The organization or other entity for which
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the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate 148 149 must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates will be 150 151 purchased and must deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. 152 The organization or other entity for which the Legislature authorized 153 the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements 154 of this subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective 155 date of the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to 156 157 permit the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

158 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this section, any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the 159 Legislature from and after July 1, 2002, the requirements of this 160 subsection must be met before the State Tax Commission may prepare 161 or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization or other 162 entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive 163 license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to the State 164 165 Tax Commission that at least two hundred (200) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the 166 167 commission an amount necessary to purchase two hundred (200) of such license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for 168 169 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (2) within 170 three (3) years after the effective date of the law authorizing 171 172 the license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued. 173

174 (3) If the organization or other entity for which the 175 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets 176 the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section, the 177 State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive 178 license tag or plate.

(4) The State Tax Commission shall review the number of
distinctive or special license tags or plates issued pursuant to
this chapter during the period for the license tag or plate
series. If the number of any distinctive or special license tag

or plate issued pursuant to this chapter falls below one hundred 183 184 (100) in the last year of the license tag or plate series, the distinctive or special license tag or plate shall be discontinued 185 186 at the end of the period for the license tag or plate series. If a distinctive or special license tag or plate is 187 (5) 188 discontinued under subsection (4) of this section, the organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate 189 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive or special license tag 190 or plate decal. The distinctive or special license tag or plate 191 decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed 192 193 upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall have final 194 195 approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The 196 distinctive or special license tag or plate decals shall be prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the 197 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by 198 199 the organization or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by 200 the organization or other entity.

295 **SECTION 4.** Section 55-15-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 296 amended as follows:

The Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission is 297 298 hereby authorized to accept gifts, grants and donations from individuals and organizations, to be deposited in the Veterans 299 300 Monument Trust Fund which is hereby created in the State Treasury. The State Treasurer shall invest all monies in the Veterans 301 Monument Trust Fund and any interest earned shall be deposited 302 into the fund. The tax collector receiving 541 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 542 543 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 544 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 545 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 546

Such evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a 1045 1046 Report of Separation from Military Service, a military discharge 1047 document, or a written certification of military service from the State Veterans Affairs Board. The distinctive license plates or 1048 1049 tags so issued shall be used only upon a personally or jointly 1050 owned private passenger vehicle (to include station wagons, recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the 1051 name, or jointly in the name, of the person making application 1052 1053 therefor, and when issued to such person shall be used upon the 1054 vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate or license tag normally issued for such vehicle. 1055

1056The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable1057between motor vehicle owners; and in the event the owner of a

1058 vehicle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange or 1059 otherwise dispose of the vehicle, such plate shall be retained by 1060 such owner and returned to the tax collector.

1061 SECTION 15. Section 27-19-56.55, Mississippi Code of 1972, 1062 is amended as follows:

1063 27-19-56.55. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 1064 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol and who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 1065 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 1066 1067 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 1068 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 1069 1070 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 1071 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol. The 1072 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and 1073 1074 design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist 1075 of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the 1076 1077 State Tax Commission, display the county name.

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 1078 1079 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such 1080 1081 distinctive license tags shall present proof that they are a 1082 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol by presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the 1083 1084 Commissioner of Public Safety. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars 1085 (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 1086 1087 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee 1088 1089 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund. 1090

1091 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 1092 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license SS26\HB940A.J

tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 1093 1094 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 1095 1096 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 1097 1098 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 1099 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 1100 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 1101 1102 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 1103 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 1104 collector.

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify * * * the total fees collected under this section * * * to the State Treasurer who shall distribute * * * such collections as follows:

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section 27-19-44.2.

1127 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as SS26\HB940A.J

1128 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 1129 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 1130 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 1131 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 1132 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 1133 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 1134 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 1135 1136 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 1137 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 1138 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 1139 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 1140 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 1141 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 1142 1143 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section. 1144
