Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person to willfully
- 6 and maliciously taunt, torment, tease, beat, strike, or to
- 7 administer, expose or inject any desensitizing drugs, chemicals or
- 8 substance to any public service animal. Any person who violates
- 9 this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction
- 10 thereof shall be fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
- 11 and be imprisoned not more than five (5) days, or both.
- 12 (2) Any person who, without just cause, purposely kills or
- 13 injures any public service animal is guilty of a felony and upon
- 14 conviction shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 15 (\$5,000.00) and be imprisoned not more than five (5) years, or
- 16 both.
- 17 (3) For purposes of this section, the term "public service
- 18 animal" means any animal trained and used to assist a law
- 19 enforcement agency, public safety entity or search and rescue
- 20 agency.
- 21 (4) Any person guilty of violating subsection (2) of this
- 22 section shall also be required to make restitution to the law
- 23 enforcement agency or owner aggrieved thereby.
- 24 (5) The provisions of this section shall not apply to the

- lawful practice of veterinary medicine. 25
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26
- and after July 1, 2003. 27

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE KILLING OF, INJURY TO, OR THE ADMINISTERING OF CERTAIN SUBSTANCES TO PUBLIC SERVICE ANIMALS; TO 2
- ENACT PENALTIES THEREFOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
