separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002, data, 131 for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 132 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 133 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 134 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 135 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 136 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 137 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in 138 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 139 140 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 141 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 142 143 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 144 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 145 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 146 147 the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law, except that no transfers shall be made which reduce funds allocated in Section 3 to Regional Facilities or Private Prisons.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
