With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 40 41 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 43 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 44 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 45 46 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 51 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 52 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 53

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 54 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 55 56 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 57

SECTION 3. If not needed for other purposes, the State 58 59 Treasurer shall invest any part of or all monies herein approved SS05\HB1512A.J

60 and any surplus funds of the State Board of Cosmetology for a 61 period of ninety (90) days or more at the highest rate of interest 62 obtainable and credit such to this respective fund. Monies shall be invested by the Treasurer in any short-term bonds, notes or 63 other direct obligations of the United States of America or the 64 State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of this state, 65 which county or municipal bonds have been approved by a reputable 66 bond attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court, or 67 in savings accounts or certificates of deposit of a state or 68 national bank in the State of Mississippi, or in federally insured 69 savings and loan associations in the State of Mississippi; and in 70 any event, the bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are 71 72 invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so invested will be needed for the purposes herein provided. 73

74 **SECTION 4.** It is the intent of this legislation to provide 75 the funds for the board to meet when necessary, but under no 76 circumstances shall it meet more than sixty-two (62) days a year.

77 SECTION 5. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 78 this act, Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-seven Dollars 79 (\$5,897.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing 80 positions of this agency.

81 SECTION 6. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable 82 Compensation Plan to ensure that the Executive Director shall 83 receive, beginning on July 1, 2003, a pay increase of Five 84 Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-six Dollars (\$5,846.00).

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 85 86 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 87 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 88 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 89 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 90 91 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2003. 92
