Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Board
8	of Nursing, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
10	June 30, 2004\$ 1,552,945.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health
13	Care Expendable Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the
14	Mississippi Board of Nursing for the support of the Nursing
15	Workforce Training Program for the fiscal year beginning
16	July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 \$ 100,000.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
19	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
20	expenditure:

37	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
38	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
39	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
40	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004
41	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
42	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the
43	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
44	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
45	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
46	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
47	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
48	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
49	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
50	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
51	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
52	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
53	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
54	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
55	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
56	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
57	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
58	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
59	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 61 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 62 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 63 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 64 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 65 this act, Thirty-nine Thousand Four Hundred Three Dollars
- 66 (\$39,403.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing
- 67 positions of this agency.
- 68 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 69 this act, Thirty Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-one Dollars
- 70 (\$30,691.00) shall be used to adjust the Variable Compensation
- 71 Plan to ensure that the Professional Licensing Officer positions
- 72 shall receive, beginning on July 1, 2003, a pay increase.
- 73 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 77 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 78 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 79 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after July 1, 2003.
