With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 44 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 45 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 47 48 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 50 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 51 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 52 53 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 58 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 60

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

62 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 63 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 64 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
allocated in Section 2 in the category "Personal Services:
Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," not more than Fifty Thousand
Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to pay overtime compensation
for work on data processing records after regular office hours.

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 70 71 necessary, while remaining within the project cost of Sixteen Million Four Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-five 72 Dollars (\$16,432,885.00) is hereby appropriated out of any money 73 74 in the State Treasury to the credit of the Building Fund Expense 75 Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of construction and renovation to the existing building and 76 parking facilities located at 429 Mississippi Street in Jackson, 77 78 Mississippi, including architectural fees and furnishings, as well as associated moving expenses and to provide monies for the lease 79 of facilities while the construction/renovation is underway, for 80 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 81 \$15,331,650.00. 82

The expenditure of funds appropriated under this section shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, and the Department of Finance and Administration shall submit an annual report regarding such expenditures to the Legislative Budget Office, the House Public Buildings, Grounds and Lands Committee and the Senate Public Property Committee.

SECTION 5. In accordance with the purposes of this article, 89 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public 90 Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund, 91 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income 92 93 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal 94 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the 95 96 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have 97 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System 98 Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed 99 One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) for repair 100 101 and maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building 102 103 Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this article and for the purposes designated herein. 104

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 105 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 106 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 107 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 108 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 109 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 110 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 111 and after July 1, 2003. 112
