With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 40 41 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 42 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 43 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 46 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 48 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 49 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 50 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 51 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 52 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 53 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 54 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 55 56 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 58 59 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until SS05\HB1531A.J

60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 67 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 68 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 70 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 71 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 72 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 74 and after July 1, 2003.
