| 20 | No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be |
| 21 | used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are |

| 23 | act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. |
| 24 | SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the |

- 25 Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall have the authority
- 26 to accept, budget and expend any source funds not to exceed Two
- 27 Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). Such funds are to be escalated
- 28 in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as
- 29 established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and
- 30 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth
- 31 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the
- 32 State Fiscal Officer.
- 33 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 34 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 35 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 36 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 37 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 38 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
