Further, unless otherwise excepted in this paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be 38 authorized to receive such funds until such time as the amount 39 appropriated for such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight 40 41 Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the 42 Elvis Presley Trauma Center, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for 43 44 their participation in the Trauma Care System. SECTION 4. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 69 70 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 71 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 72 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 73 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 74 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 75 76 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 77 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 78 79 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 80 81 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 82 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 83 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 84 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 85 86 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 87 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 88 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 89

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance withthe terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

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95 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

96 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 97 State Department of Health may escalate any special funds and 98 positions not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). Such 99 escalation shall be submitted to and approved by the Department of 100 Finance and Administration in the manner consistent with the 101 escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 102 Department of Health shall have the authority to expend any 103 special funds collected or otherwise available, notwithstanding 104 105 any restrictions in the general law or statutes earmarking said funds for a particular use, that are in excess of the amounts 106 107 needed for the purpose of such fund, for the purpose of providing maternal and child health, family planning and disease control 108 109 services.

110 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with 111 the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may 112 provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to 113 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such 114 vaccinations through job related exposure.

SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums heretofore 115 116 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 117 Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water 118 119 Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in 120 121 Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and 122 Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year 123 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 124\$ 125 33,552,000.00.

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that in the event that there are insufficient Child Care Development Block Grant Funds, then the Department of Health shall maintain the Child Care Licensure Program at the same level that the program SS05\HB1544A.1J 130 was in Fiscal Year 1993 using any other funds.

131 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of 132 133 Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. 134 These 135 funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no later than July 31, 2003. The State Department of Health shall 136 make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 137 Department of Human Services. 138

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 139 140 State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 141 142 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder 143 adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 144 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder 145 146 adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 147 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed pathology and biannual MRI exams. 148

SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore 149 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 150 151 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as 152 153 authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery 154 Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the 155 156 State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 8,000,000.00. 157 It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds 158

159 appropriated in this section, an amount of Two Million Five 160 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund the 161 School Tobacco Nurse Program.

162 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven 163 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the 164 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and AIDS related services.

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SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the amounts of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to the T. K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program.

171SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand172Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Osteoporosis Program.

SECTION 16. In addition to all other funds heretofore 173 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 174 175 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department 176 177 of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of 178 funding the Federal Bioterrorism Preparedness Program to the State 179 Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, 180 181 and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 12,300,000.00.

SECTION 17. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, Two Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$277,373.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing positions of this agency.

SECTION 18. In addition to all other sums heretofore appropriated, the following sum is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Health for the purpose of providing funds to the Elvis Presley Trauma Center for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003...... 511,185.00.

192 It is the intention of the Legislature that the State 193 Department of Health shall, within fifteen (15) working days after 194 passage of this act, provide the entire amount of funds 195 appropriated in this Section to the Elvis Presley Trauma Center to 196 ensure the center receives their appropriate share of the Six 197 Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) appropriated in Fiscal Year 2003 198 for the Trauma Care System.

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SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SS05\HB1544A.1J

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 200 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 201 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 202 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 203 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 204 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from 205 and after July 1, 2003, except for Section 18 which shall take 206 effect and be in force from and after its passage. 207
