- 74 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
- 75 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
- 76 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles
- 77 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply
- 78 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 79 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 80 this act, Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars
- 81 (\$13,417.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing
- 82 positions of this agency.
- 83 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 84 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 85 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 86 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 88 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 89 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 90 and after July 1, 2003.
