2	renumbering subsequent sections accordingly:
3	SECTION *. Section 27-19-56.55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4	amended as follows:
5	27-19-56.55. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
6	retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol and who is
7	a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge
8	privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
9	prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
10	trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
11	an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
12	section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor
13	vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
14	retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol. The
15	distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and
16	design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist
17	of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
18	distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the
19	State Tax Commission, display the county name.
20	(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
21	by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
22	prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such
23	distinctive license tags shall present proof that they are a

- 24 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol by
- 25 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 26 Commissioner of Public Safety. The application and the additional
- 27 fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars
- 28 (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 29 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 30 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee
- 31 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county
- 32 general fund.
- 33 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 34 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 35 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 36 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 37 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 38 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 39 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 40 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 41 time the original application is made for a distinctive license

- (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee

- 62 <u>section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund</u>
- 63 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 64 <u>reconstruction of highways</u>.
- 65 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 67 <u>be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section</u>
- 68 <u>27-19-44.2.</u>
- 69 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 70 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 71 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 72 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 73 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 74 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 75 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 76 tag.
- 77 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 78 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 79 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
