1	AMEND by inserting the following after line 839 and by
2	renumbering subsequent sections accordingly:
3	SECTION *. Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4	amended as follows:
5	27-19-44. (1) For any distinctive license tag or plate
6	authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, through
7	June 30, 2002, or authorized by Section 27-19-56.55, the
8	requirements of this subsection must be met before the State Tax
9	Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate.
10	The organization or other entity for which the Legislature
11	authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof
12	satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least one hundred
13	(100) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must
14	deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase one
15	hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. The organization or
16	other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive
17	license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this
18	subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective date of
19	the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to permit
20	the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.
21	(2) For any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by
22	the Legislature from and after July 1, 2002, the requirements of
23	this subsection must be met before the State Tax Commission may

- 24 prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization
- 25 or other entity for which the Legislature authorized the
- 26 distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to
- 27 the State Tax Commission that at least two hundred (200) of such
- 28 license tags or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the
- 29 commission an amount necessary to purchase two hundred (200) of
- 30 such license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for
- 31 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or
- 32 plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (2) within
- 33 three (3) years after the effective date of the law authorizing
- 34 the license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or
- 35 plate to be prepared and issued.
- 36 (3) If the organization or other entity for which the
- 37 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets
- 38 the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section, the
- 39 State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive
- 40 license tag or plate.
- 41 (4) The State Tax Commission shall review the number of
- 42 distinctive or special license tags or plates issued pursuant to
- 43 this chapter during the period for the license tag or plate
- 44 series. If the number of any distinctive or special license tag
- 45 or plate issued pursuant to this chapter falls below one hundred
- 46 (100) in the last year of the license tag or plate series, the
- 47 distinctive or special license tag or plate shall be discontinued
- 48 at the end of the period for the license tag or plate series.
- 49 (5) If a distinctive or special license tag or plate is
- 50 discontinued under subsection (4) of this section, the
- 51 organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate
- 52 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive or special license tag
- 53 or plate decal. The distinctive or special license tag or plate
- 54 decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed
- 55 upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax
- 56 Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall have final
- 57 approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The
- 58 distinctive or special license tag or plate decals shall be

- 59 prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the
- 60 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by
- 61 the organization or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by
- 62 the organization or other entity.
- 63 (6) The provisions of this section shall not apply to
- 64 distinctive or special license tags or plates:
- (a) Which are issued under Section 27-19-45, 27-19-46,
- 66 27-19-47.1, 27-19-47.2, 27-19-48, 27-19-49, 27-19-53, 27-19-55,
- 67 27-19-56, 27-19-56.1, 27-19-56.2, 27-19-56.3, 27-19-56.5,
- 68 27-19-56.6, 27-19-56.9, 27-19-56.11, 27-19-56.12 or 27-19-56.13,
- 69 or under Sections 27-19-56.62 and 27-19-56.69; or
- 70 (b) For which no additional fee is required to be paid.

- 72 after the semicolon:
- 73 TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-44, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE
- 74 THE STATE TAX COMMISSION TO PREPARE AND ISSUE DISTINCTIVE LICENSE
- 75 TAGS AUTHORIZED FOR RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
- 76 SAFETY PATROL IF 100 OF SUCH TAGS WILL BE PURCHASED;
