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**AMENDMENT No. 2 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill NO. 2628**

**By Senator(s) Dawkins**

1           **AMEND** by inserting the following after line 87 and renumbering  
2 succeeding sections accordingly:

1           **(10) The board shall report to the State Board of Medical**  
2 **Licensure any judgment of an amount in excess of Fifty Thousand**  
3 **Dollars (\$50,000.00) caused by a participating physician's negligence,**  
4 **error or omission in practice, or his rendering unauthorized**  
5 **professional services. The report shall contain the name and license**  
6 **number of the physician and shall be sent within thirty (30) calendar**  
7 **days after entry of judgment.**

8           **SECTION \*** **The State Medical Board of Licensure shall disclose**  
9 **to an inquiring member of the public information received pursuant to**  
10 **Section 4(10) of this act regarding convictions of, and judgments**

11 **against, physicians participating in the Medical Malpractice Insurance**  
12 **Availability Plan. The State Medical Board of Licensure may formulate**  
13 **appropriate disclaimers or explanatory statements to be included with**  
14 **any information released, and may, by regulation, establish categories**  
15 **of information that need not be disclosed to the public because that**  
16 **information is unreliable or not sufficiently related to the licensee's**  
17 **professional practice. Beginning July 1, 2003, the State Medical Board**  
18 **of Licensure shall develop and operate a website and make the**  
19 **information received pursuant to Section 4(10) of this act available on**  
20 **its website.**

21 **FURTHER, amend the title to conform.**
