AMENDMENT No. 3 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2628

By Senator(s) Dawkins

1 **AMEND** by inserting the following new section after line 301
2 and renumbering the succeeding section accordingly:

3 **SECTION *** Within ten (10) days after a judgment by a court
4 of this state that a person who holds a license, certificate or
5 other similar authority from the State Board of Medical Licensure
6 has committed a crime, or is liable for any death or personal
7 injury resulting in a judgment of an amount in excess of Fifty
8 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) caused by his negligence, error or
9 omission in practice, or his rendering unauthorized professional
10 services, the clerk of the court that rendered the judgment shall
11 report that fact to the State Board of Medical Licensure.

12 (2) Every insurer providing professional liability insurance
13 to a physician licensed pursuant to Section 73-25-1 et seq. shall
14 send a complete report, including the name and license number of
15 the physician, to the State Board of Medical Licensure as to any
16 judgment of an amount in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars
17 (\$50,000.00) caused by that licensee's negligence, error or
18 omission in practice, or his rendering unauthorized professional
19 services. The report shall be sent within thirty (30) calendar
20 days after entry of judgment.

21 **SECTION *** The State Medical Board of Licensure shall
22 disclose to an inquiring member of the public information received
23 pursuant to Section 7 of this act regarding convictions of, and

24 judgments against, a physician. The board may formulate
25 appropriate disclaimers or explanatory statements to be included
26 with any information released, and may, by regulation, establish
27 categories of information that need not be disclosed to the public
28 because that information is unreliable or not sufficiently related
29 to the licensee's professional practice. Beginning July 1, 2003,
30 the board shall develop and operate a website and make the
31 information received pursuant to Section 7 of this act available
32 on its website.
