Lost AMENDMENT No. 3 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2628

1 AMEND by inserting the following new section after line 301 2 and renumbering the succeeding section accordingly:

<u>SECTION *.</u> Within ten (10) days after a judgment by a court 3 of this state that a person who holds a license, certificate or 4 other similar authority from the State Board of Medical Licensure 5 has committed a crime, or is liable for any death or personal 6 7 injury resulting in a judgment of an amount in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) caused by his negligence, error or 8 omission in practice, or his rendering unauthorized professional 9 services, the clerk of the court that rendered the judgment shall 10 report that fact to the State Board of Medical Licensure. 11

12 (2) Every insurer providing professional liability insurance to a physician licensed pursuant to Section 73-25-1 et seq. shall 13 send a complete report, including the name and license number of 14 the physician, to the State Board of Medical Licensure as to any 15 judgment of an amount in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars 16 (\$50,000.00) caused by that licensee's negligence, error or 17 omission in practice, or his rendering unauthorized professional 18 services. The report shall be sent within thirty (30) calendar 19 20 days after entry of judgment.

21 <u>SECTION *.</u> The State Medical Board of Licensure shall 22 disclose to an inquiring member of the public information received 23 pursuant to Section 7 of this act regarding convictions of, and

judgments against, a physician. The board may formulate 24 appropriate disclaimers or explanatory statements to be included 25 with any information released, and may, by regulation, establish 26 categories of information that need not be disclosed to the public 27 28 because that information is unreliable or not sufficiently related to the licensee's professional practice. Beginning July 1, 2003, 29 the board shall develop and operate a website and make the 30 information received pursuant to Section 7 of this act available 31 on its website. 32

33 FURTHER, amend the title to conform.
