Lost AMENDMENT No. 6 PROPOSED TO

Committee Sub. for SB NO. 2648

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 11 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (a) "Health care facility" means a hospital,
- 12 nursing facility or other health care facility that is licensed or
- 13 regulated by the State Department of Health.
- 14 (b) "Public conveyance" means buses, taxis, trains,
- 15 trolleys, boats and other means of public transit when used for
- 16 public conveyance.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** (1) Smoking is prohibited in all health care
- 18 facilities and public conveyances in the State of Mississippi
- 19 **SECTION 3.** (1) Every place where smoking is prohibited by
- 20 this act shall have posted at every entrance a conspicuous sign
- 21 clearly stating that smoking is prohibited.
- 22 (2) All ashtrays and other smoking paraphernalia shall be
- 23 removed from any area where smoking is prohibited by this act by
- 24 the owner, operator, manager or other person having control of
- 25 that area.
- 26 **SECTION 4.** The State Board of Health shall adopt and
- 27 promulgate regulations and penalties regarding the violations of
- 28 this act not later than ninety (90) days after the effective date
- 29 of this act.
- 30 **SECTION 5.** Section 29-5-161, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 31 amended as follows:
- 32 29-5-161. (1) As used in this section:
- 33 (a) "Smoke" or "smoking" means inhaling, exhaling,
- 34 burning, carrying or otherwise possessing any lighted cigarette,
- 35 cigar, pipe or any other object or device of any form that
- 36 contains lighted tobacco or any other smoking product.
- 37 (b) "Government building" means the New State Capitol
- 38 Building, the Woolfolk State Office Building, the Carroll Gartin
- 39 Justice Building, the Walter Sillers Office Building, the Heber
- 40 Ladner Building, the Department of Transportation Building, the
- 41 Robert E. Lee Office Building, the 301 Lamar Street Building, the
- 42 State Board of Health Building, the Public Employees' Retirement
- 43 System Building, the Central High Building, the Court of Appeals
- 44 Building, the War Veterans' Memorial Building, the State Archives
- 45 Building, the Ike Sanford Veterans Affairs Building, the Old State
- 46 Capitol Building, the Burroughs Building, the Mayfair Building,
- 47 101 Capitol Centre and any other facility in the state that is
- 48 owned or leased by the State of Mississippi or any agency,
- 49 department or institution of the state and that is used for
- 50 housing state employees during the time of performance of their
- 51 regular duties for the state; any building owned, rented, leased,
- 52 occupied or operated by the state, including the legislative,
- 53 <u>executive and judicial branches of state government; any county,</u>
- 54 municipality or any other political subdivision of the state; any
- 55 public authority, commission, agency or public benefit
- 56 <u>corporation; or any other separate corporate instrumentality or</u>
- 57 <u>unit of state or local government</u>. If only part of a facility is
- 18 leased by the state or an agency, department or institution of the
- 59 state, or any county, municipality or other political subdivision
- of the state, only the leased part of the facility will be
- 61 considered to be a <u>qovernment</u> building for the purposes of this
- 62 definition.

- 64 (2) No person shall smoke in any government building * * *.
- 65 *** * ***

- 66 (3) The person, agency or entity having jurisdiction or
- 67 supervision over a government building shall not allow smoking in
- 68 the <u>government</u> building, * * * and shall use reasonable efforts to
- 69 prevent smoking in the government building, * * * including, but
- 70 not limited to, the following:
- 71 (a) Posting appropriate signs informing <u>public</u>
- 72 employees, invitees, guests and other persons that smoking is
- 73 prohibited in the government building * * *.
- 74 (b) Securing the removal of persons who smoke in the
- 75 government building * * *.
- 76 $\underline{(4)}$ This section expressly preempts to the state the
- 77 regulation of smoking in government buildings and supersedes any
- 78 municipal or county ordinance on the subject.
- 79 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS, HEALTH
- 2 CARE FACILITIES AND PUBLIC CONVEYANCES IN THE STATE OF
- 3 MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTING OF NO SMOKING SIGNS; TO
- 4 DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH TO ADOPT REGULATIONS AND
- 5 PENALTIES REGARDING VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; TO AMEND SECTION
- 6 29-5-161, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THERE SHALL BE
- 7 NO DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS IN STATE OFFICE BUILDINGS AND TO
- 8 PROVIDE THAT SMOKING PROHIBITIONS APPLY TO ANY GOVERNMENT
- 9 BUILDING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
