HOUSE BILL NO. 247

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT STUDENTS COMPLETE A STATE CERTIFIED DRIVER EDUCATION TRAINING PROGRAM IN ORDER TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL; TO AMEND SECTION 37-25-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAINTAINING A SECONDARY SCHOOL TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN DRIVER EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 11 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 12 minimum:
- 13 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 14 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 15 Education.
- 16 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 17 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 18 school board.
- 19 (c) For high schools, completion of a state certified
- 20 driver education and training program.
- 21 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 22 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 23 in a form prescribed by the state board.
- 24 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 25 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 26 graduation.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** Section 37-25-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 28 amended as follows:

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29	37-25-3. The school board of every school district
30	maintaining a secondary school which includes any of the Grades 9
31	through 12 inclusive <u>shall</u> establish and maintain driver education
32	and training programs for pupils enrolled in the day secondary
33	schools in that district.

34 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after July 1, 2004.
