HOUSE BILL NO. 560

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-92, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 AUTHORIZE STATE AGENCIES TO GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE WITH PAY TO 2 3 EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CERTIFIED DISASTER SERVICE VOLUNTEERS OF THE 4 AMERICAN RED CROSS PARTICIPATING IN RELIEF SERVICES WITHIN ANY STATE IN THE UNITED STATES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-92, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8

9 25-3-92. (1) When, in the opinion of the appointing 10 authority, it is essential that a state employee work after normal 11 working hours, the employee may receive credit for compensatory 12 leave. Except as otherwise provided in Section 37-13-89, when, in 13 the opinion of the appointing authority, it is essential that a 14 state employee work during an official state holiday, the employee 15 shall receive credit for compensatory leave.

16 (2) State employees may be granted administrative leave with 17 pay. For the purposes of this section, "administrative leave" 18 means discretionary leave with pay, other than personal leave or 19 major medical leave.

(a) The appointing authority may grant administrative
leave to any employee serving as a witness or juror or party
litigant, as verified by the clerk of the court, in addition to
any fees paid for such services, and such services or necessary
appearance in any court shall not be counted as personal leave.

25 (b) The Governor or the appointing authority may grant 26 administrative leave with pay to state employees on a local or 27 statewide basis in the event of extreme weather conditions or in 28 the event of a manmade, technological or natural disaster or 29 emergency.

The appointing authority may grant administrative 30 (C) 31 leave with pay to any employee who is a certified disaster service 32 volunteer of the American Red Cross who participates in specialized disaster relief services for the American Red Cross 33 within any state in the United States when the American Red Cross 34 requests the employee's participation. Administrative leave 35 granted under this paragraph shall not exceed twenty (20) days in 36 any twelve-month period. An employee on leave under this 37 38 paragraph shall not be deemed to be an employee of the state for purposes of workers' compensation or for purposes of claims 39 against the state allowed under Chapter 46, Title 11, Mississippi 40 Code of 1972. As used in this paragraph, the term "disaster" 41 includes disasters designated at level II and above in American 42 Red Cross national regulations and procedures. 43

44 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force
45 retroactively from and after September 10, 2001.
