HOUSE BILL NO. 576

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR THE OPERATOR OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EVADING DETECTION OF A CRIMINAL VIOLATION, TO AVOID A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT; TO
- 4 PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for the operator of any motor
- 7 vehicle, for the purpose of evading detection of a criminal
- 8 violation, to stop, turn, flee or otherwise avoid driving through
- 9 or around a driver's license or sobriety checkpoint set up by a
- 10 law enforcement officer or law enforcement agency.
- 11 (2) Any person who violates subsection (1) of this section
- 12 shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than
- 13 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after July 1, 2004.
