HOUSE BILL NO. 605

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-11-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO REQUIRE ALL HOTELS OR LODGING HOUSES TO HAVE MISSISSIPPI FIRE
3	PREVENTION CODE-APPROVED ELECTRIC FIRE DETECTORS ON EACH FLOOR; TO
4	AMEND SECTION 45-11-49, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE
5	PENALTIES FOR FAILURE OF LESSEES AND KEEPERS OF HOTELS OR LODGING
6	HOUSES TO PROVIDE CERTAIN FIRE ALARMS AND ESCAPE APPLIANCES; TO
7	REPEAL SECTION 45-11-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH REQUIRES
8	PROPRIETORS OR KEEPERS OF ALL HOTELS OR PUBLIC LODGING HOUSES TO
9	PROVIDE A LARGE FIRE ALARM BELL OR GONG NEAR THE OFFICE; AND FOR
10	RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-11-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 45-11-29. All hotels or lodging houses * * * shall be
- 15 provided with a Mississippi Fire Prevention Code-approved electric
- 16 fire detector with a detector * * * on each floor * * *.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** Section 45-11-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 18 amended as follows:
- 19 45-11-49. Every owner, lessee, keeper, or proprietor of a
- 20 hotel or a lodging house who shall, when the same is prescribed by
- 21 law to be done, fail, neglect or refuse:
- 22 (a) To provide for each room a rope or rope ladder, or
- 23 other like appliance; or
- 24 (b) To give notice calling attention to such rope or
- 25 rope ladder or appliance, and giving directions for its use; or
- 26 (c) To provide iron balconies with iron stairs; or
- 27 (d) To provide a hand or side rail to each stairway; or
- 28 (e) To * * * provide a Mississippi Fire Prevention
- 29 Code-approved electric fire detector; or

- 32 his house in case of fire therein or in close proximity thereto;
- 33 or
- 34 (g) To do everything in case of fire in his power to
- 35 rescue the guests or inmates of his house; or
- 36 (h) To do anything required by law to be done under the
- 37 provisions of Sections 45-11-21 through 45-11-55;
- 38 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction, shall be
- 39 punished by imprisonment in the county jail not less than ninety
- 40 (90) days nor more than six (6) months, or fined not less than One
- 41 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars
- 42 (\$1,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment.
- 43 **SECTION 3.** Section 45-11-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 44 requires keepers of all hotels and public lodging houses to
- 45 provide a large fire alarm bell or gong near the office, is
- 46 repealed.
- 47 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2004.
