## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 768

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-516, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO OPERATES A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHIN A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE IN EXCESS OF THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT 3 4 SPECIFICALLY ESTABLISHED FOR THAT ZONE MAY BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF DOUBLE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY LAW IF SIGNS 6 OR OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES APPROVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI 7 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ARE POSTED IN THE AREA WARNING THAT A VIOLATION OF THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED LIMIT WHILE WORKERS ARE 8 PRESENT MAY BE PUNISHED BY SUCH INCREASED FINE; AND FOR RELATED 9 10 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-516, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows: 63-3-516. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to 14 operate a motor vehicle within a highway work zone at a speed in 15 excess of the maximum speed limit specifically established for the 16 zone whenever workers are present and whenever the zone is 17 indicated by appropriately placed signs displaying the reduced 18 19 maximum speed limit. Any person violating the provisions of this 20 section shall be punished, upon conviction, for a first offense by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00; and 21 for a second, third or subsequent offense by a fine of not more 22 than double the maximum amount of the applicable fine prescribed 23 for second, third or subsequent offenses under Section 63-9-11. 24 25 (2) For the purposes of this section the term "highway work 26 zone" means a construction or maintenance area that is located on or along any public highway, road or street within this state and 27 that is marked by \* \* \* signs or other traffic control devices of 28 29 a design approved by the Mississippi Department of Transportation 30 warning that any person who operates a motor vehicle within the

designated area at a speed in excess of the reduced maximum speed

- 34 (3) Nothing in this section shall preclude the prosecution
- 35 or conviction for reckless driving of any motor vehicle operator
- 36 whose operation of a motor vehicle in a highway work zone, apart
- 37 from speed, demonstrates a reckless disregard for life, limb or

- 39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
