3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI
4	SECTION 1. For purposes of this chapter, the following terms
5	shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section:
6	(a) "Marina" means a facility providing mooring spaces
7	for boats that may provide supplies and services including
8	electricity, fresh water, fuel or sewage collection facilities.
9	(b) "Public marina" means a marina that offers mooring

- 9 (b) "Public marina" means a marina that offers mooring
 10 spaces and docking facilities for lease by the general public.
 11 Public marinas include recreational and commercial marinas, and
 12 they require a "C" for commercial or "I" for industrial use
 13 designation.
- 14 (c) "Private single-family or multi-family marina"
- 15 means a marina that is part of an adjacent single-family home
- 16 subdivision or multi-family condominium or apartment development
- 17 that provides mooring spaces and docking facilities restricted for
- 18 use by only home owners or tenants of the adjacent development.
- 19 Private single-family and multi-family marinas with twelve (12) or
- 20 fewer mooring spaces are compatible with a "G" for general use
- 21 designation. Private single-family and multi-family marinas with
- 22 more than twelve (12) mooring spaces require a "C" for commercial
- 23 use designation. Commercial vessels may not be moored in a
- 24 private single-family or multi-family marina.
- 25 (d) "Yacht club marina" means a marina that restricts
- 26 mooring spaces and docking facilities to members only of a private

- 27 association organization. Yacht clubs require a "C" for
- 28 commercial or "I" for industrial use designation.
- 29 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 30 and after July 1, 2004.
