## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 805

1	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY STATE AGENCY FROM PURCHASING
2	EQUIPMENT, HIRING NEW EMPLOYEES, OR PROMOTING, RECLASSIFYING,
3	REALLOCATING OR REALIGNING PAY GRADES WITH REGARD TO ANY OF ITS
4	EMPLOYEES OR JOB POSITIONS DURING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR; TO
5	ESTABLISH AN APPEAL PROCEDURE TO THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER FOR
6	AGENCIES SEEKING TO TAKE ANY ACTION THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE
7	PROHIBITED BY THIS ACT; TO SET FORTH THE DEMONSTRATION OF THE
8	EMERGENCY THAT MUST BE MADE BY THE AGENCY IN ITS APPEAL; TO
9	PROVIDE THAT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE SHALL BE
10	NOTIFIED OF SUCH AN APPEAL AND THAT COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY ATTEND
11	THE HEARING ON SUCH AN APPEAL; TO ALLOW THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER,
12	IN HIS DISCRETION, TO AUTHORIZE THE ACTION SOUGHT IN THE APPEAL;
13	TO AMEND SECTION 25-9-116, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY
14	THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
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16	<b>SECTION 1.</b> (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsections

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- (2) and (3) of this section, due to the severe budget concerns 17
- during the current fiscal year, the following provisions shall 18
- apply through June 30, 2004: 19
- (a) No state agency is authorized to purchase any 20
- 21 equipment as defined in Section 31-7-1.
- 22 (b) No state agency is authorized to hire any new
- employees, or promote, reclassify, reallocate or realign a pay 23
- grade with regard to any of its employees or job positions. The 24
- State Personnel Board shall immediately suspend all hirings, 25
- promotions, reclassifications, reallocations and pay grade 26
- realignments of employees or job positions. 27
- 28 (2) If a state agency determines that it is necessary to
- 29 take any action that otherwise would be prohibited under
- subsection (1) of this section before July 1, 2004, the agency may 30
- 31 appeal to the State Fiscal Officer. The State Fiscal Officer
- shall immediately notify the Joint Legislative Budget Committee of 32
- the state agency's appeal and the date upon which the State Fiscal 33 \*HR03/R1303CS\* H. B. No. 805

- 34 Officer will hold a hearing on the appeal. The State Fiscal
- 35 Officer shall grant a hearing to the state agency on its appeal
- 36 within fifteen (15) days after notice of the appeal is given to
- 37 the State Fiscal Officer. The hearing shall not be a public
- 38 meeting; however, any member of the Joint Legislative Budget
- 39 Committee may attend the hearing. At the hearing, the state
- 40 agency must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the State Fiscal
- 41 Officer that a serious emergency exists of such magnitude that the
- 42 essential mission of the agency cannot be carried out without
- 43 taking an action that otherwise would be prohibited under
- 44 subsection (1) of this section. In making his decision, the State
- 45 Fiscal Officer may consider the source of funds to be used by the
- 46 state agency in taking that action. If the state agency makes the
- 47 demonstration required by this subsection, the State Fiscal
- 48 Officer, in his discretion, may authorize the agency to take the
- 49 action sought by the agency that otherwise would be prohibited
- 50 under subsection (1) of this section.
- 51 (3) For purposes of this section, the term "state agency"
- 52 means any agency, board, commission or department of the State of
- 53 Mississippi.
- 54 **SECTION 2.** Section 25-9-116, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 55 amended as follows:
- [Through June 30, 2004, this section will read as follows:]
- 57 25-9-116. \* \* \* The State Personnel Board shall institute an
- 58 immediate suspension of all hirings, promotions,
- 59 reclassifications, reallocations and pay grade realignments, as
- 60 provided in Section 1 of this act.
- [From and after July 1, 2004, this section will read as
- 62 follows:]
- 63 25-9-116. Upon recommendation of the State Fiscal Officer,
- 64 after a determination that the state revenue and expenditure
- 65 requires such action, the State Personnel Board may institute an
- 66 immediate suspension of all hirings, promotions,

- 67 reclassifications, reallocations and pay grade realignments until
- 68 such time as the State Fiscal Officer shall recommend that such
- 69 action is no longer required.
- 70 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 71 and after its passage.
