## HOUSE BILL NO. 824

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE MISSISSIPPI 1 VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM; TO VEST TITLE TO SUCH PROPERTY IN THE 2 3 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER; TO AMEND SECTIONS 55-23-13, 55-23-15, 55-23-17, 55-23-19 AND 55-23-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; TO REPEAL SECTIONS 55-23-1, 55-23-3, 4 5 55-23-5, 55-23-7, 55-23-8, 55-23-9 AND 55-23-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI VETERAN MEMORIAL STADIUM б 7 8 ACT," PROVIDE FOR THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL COMMISSION AND PROVIDE FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF THE STADIUM; AND FOR 9 10 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** The Department of Finance Administration shall contract for the demolition of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium. After the stadium has been demolished, title to the property shall be vested in the University of Mississippi Medical Center.

SECTION 2. Section 55-23-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

55-23-13. The State Highway Department is hereby authorized 19 20 and empowered to maintain the driveways which lead to the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium and are a part of the 21 state-owned real property under the jurisdiction of the University 22 of Mississippi Medical Center. In carrying out this section, the 23 department is authorized to use its personnel, funds, equipment 24 and machinery, and it may accept donations of funds from said 25 26 commission, the City of Jackson, and Hinds County, which funds are 27 hereby authorized to be expended, and other grants and bequests for carrying out the provisions of this section. 28

29 SECTION 3. Section 55-23-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 30 amended as follows:

55-23-15. The University of Mississippi Medical Center is 31 32 hereby authorized to utilize certain state-owned land in Hinds 33 County bounded on the east by North State Street, on the north by 34 Taylor Street, on the west by North West Street, and on the south 35 by a street or driveway known as Stadium Drive as a public parking 36 facility establishing reasonable rules and regulations connected with the operation of such a facility, including fees for the 37 privilege of parking. The parking facilities shall not be 38 extended any farther to the east than as the facilities existed on 39 January 1, 1996. Further, the portion of the property described 40 41 in this section, except the property west of the stadium between the stadium and North West Street, that was undeveloped as of 42 43 January 1, 1996, shall remain undeveloped unless the Legislature 44 enacts legislation approving the development of such property. 45 The portion of the property described in this section that is west of the stadium between the stadium and North West Street may be 46 47 developed to provide parking facilities for the Mississippi 48 Department of Transportation offices located on North West Street. The University of Mississippi Medical Center may take any action 49 50 authorized in Section 55-23-8 relating to the property described 51 in such section.

52 SECTION 4. Section 55-23-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 53 amended as follows:

54 55-23-17. The <u>University of Mississippi Medical Center</u> is 55 authorized to establish penalties for tow-away or impoundment 56 charges for individual or corporate owners of vehicles violating 57 such rules and regulations; and such other general rules and 58 regulations as may be reasonably necessary.

59 SECTION 5. Section 55-23-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
60 amended as follows:

61 55-23-19. Prior to July 1, 1989, the commission shall 62 contract with the University of Mississippi Medical Center for 63 provision by the medical center of funds in an amount reasonable H. B. No. 824 \*HR40/R509\* 04/HR40/R509 PAGE 2 (CJR\BD) 64 and necessary to provide the following maintenance of parking

65 facilities at the stadium:

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(a) Adequate lighting;

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(b) Routine care of the parking surface;

68 (c) Long-term resurfacing of any parking area utilized69 by medical center employees, students and patients; and

(d) Security.

In consideration of the funds provided by the medical center, the University of Mississippi Medical Center students, employees, patients and visitors, and all other state employees, will be exempt from payment of any fees imposed **\* \* \*** for the use of the parking facilities at the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium when there are no special events being held on the stadium grounds.

78 SECTION 6. Section 55-23-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
79 amended as follows:

80 55-23-21. The Building Commission is hereby authorized and empowered, in addition to all other powers and duties of such 81 commission, to enlarge and renovate the Mississippi Veterans 82 83 Memorial Stadium in order to provide for a modern stadium having a seating capacity of approximately sixty-two thousand seven hundred 84 85 thirty-one (62,731) persons, such authority to be conditioned upon a contribution by Hinds County, Mississippi, to the Building 86 Commission of a sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for 87 88 such enlargement and renovation. The parking facilities shall not be extended any farther to the east than as the facilities existed 89 90 on January 1, 1996. Further, the portion of the state-owned 91 property on which the stadium and parking facilities are located, except the property west of the stadium between the stadium and 92 North West Street, that was undeveloped as of January 1, 1996, 93 94 shall remain undeveloped unless the Legislature enacts legislation 95 approving the development of such property. The portion of the state-owned property on which the stadium is located that is west 96 \*HR40/R509\* 824 H. B. No. 04/HR40/R509

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97 of the stadium between the stadium and North West Street may be 98 developed to provide parking facilities for the Mississippi 99 Department of Transportation offices located on North West 100 Street. \* \* \* 101 SECTION 7. Sections 55-23-1, 55-23-3, 55-23-5, 55-23-7,

102 55-23-8, 55-23-9 and 55-23-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, which 103 create "the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Act," provide 104 for the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and 105 provide for the management and operation of the Mississippi 106 Veterans Memorial Stadium, are repealed.

107 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 108 and after July 1, 2004.
